COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will serve as an introduction for the ASL to English voice interpretation via lecture, textbook readings, and practical activities utilizing instructional videos.

PREREQUISITE: ASL 105, ASL 115, and ASL 120

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will:

- Develop a beginning understanding of ASL to English voice interpretation
- Understand the theory, practice and criticism of interpretation and transliteration
- Demonstrate an awareness of historical foundations in interpreting
- Show beginning knowledge of simultaneous and consecutive interpretation
- Demonstrate an awareness of the interpreting and transliterating process

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
