ASL 270 Topics in Interpreting

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will provide discussion topics in specialized areas of sign language interpreting for advanced interpreting students and working interpreters. Course may also include field trips as appropriate.

- To be aware of advanced and constantly changing topics in specialized areas of sign language interpreting
- Demonstrate a knowledge of finding good sources of current ASL information
