COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Continued emphasis will be on the four basic skills, fundamental grammatical construction and vocabulary. Expanded training in reading, writing and composition. Emphasis is on French conversation and idiomatic constructions.

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will:

- 1. Demonstrate conversation in dialogue form, give directions
- Compare the differences in the Francophone countries as they relate to the language and culture
- 3. Demonstrate a knowledge of complex grammatical structures
