COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course covers solving problems relating to bank and sales records, percentages in business, financial charges and statements, payrolls and taxes, insurance, bonds, stocks and annuities.

PREREQUISITES: MAT 100 or MAT 105

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will:

- 1. Bank services
- 2. Payroll (gross earnings, deductions)
- 3. Buying (invoices, discounts)
- 4. Selling (cost, markup, markdown)
- 5. Simple interest
- 6. Compound interest
- 7. Business and Consumer loans (optional)
