COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is a continuation of MUS 101 with increased emphasis on ear training.

PREREQUISITES: MUS 101

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will:

- 1. Be introduced to basic keyboard techniques and literature
- 2. Develop keyboard understanding and mastery of original and familiar musical selections
- 3. Develop a functional approach to playing and harmonizing simple melodies
