PDP 120 Introduction to Model Surfacing

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this course students will gain a fundamental understanding of 3D surface capture, processing, and editing using state-of-the-art surfacing software.

PREREQUISITES: PDP 100

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will:

- Demonstrate knowledge of blueprints
- Perform basic functions in industry specific software
- Demonstrate ability to process point cloud data
- Generate polygonal models resulting in a fully editable NURB surface
