COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this course students will be introduced to the assembly structure including top-down and bottom-up assemblies as well as assembly clearance analysis.

PREREQUISITES: PDP 150

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will:

- Demonstrate top-down assembly techniques
- Demonstrate bottom-up assembly techniques
- Perform assembly clearance analysis
- Demonstrate ability to correct for deviation in assembly clearance to meet the design criteria
- Follow proper safety protocols
