COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is an introduction to the law of personal property and real property. Topics covered include: title to personal property, gifts, estates in land, future interests, mortgages and landlord/tenant matters.

Upon completion of this course, students will be familiar with:

- The law as it relates to land ownership.
- What real property is.
- How the right to use land is conveyed.
- The limitations and requirements of land ownership.
- How the state controls and influences the use of property.
- The limitations which can be imposed on real property based on environmental concerns.
