COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will provide in depth coverage of the 9 knowledge areas of project management and integration with other project management models and business practice. The role of the project/program manager will be explored in relation to day to day management of a project.

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will:

1. State the essential legal differences between partnerships and corporations: prepare journal entries involving a variety of corporate stock transactions (stock splits, stock dividends, treasury stock) and compute earnings per share.
