RTV 102 Advanced Writing for Radio/TV

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will provide students with the theory and practice of voiceovers and audio production, as well as the relationship of audio work to other aspects of media production. Through this course students will be exposed to: basic audio terminology and concepts, appropriate microphone usage and placement, and recording and editing single and multiple audio tracks and how to work comfortably in a recording studio environment.
