COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This practicum in a veterinary hospital and/or biomedical setting is for the mastery of advanced technical skills. Must have the director's approval of site required.

PREREQUISITES: VTP 233

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will demonstrate the ability to complete the following tasks with minimal supervision:

- 1. Assist in routine health procedures
- 2. Prepare, administer, and monitor anesthesia
- 3. Assist in surgery
- 4. Surgical preparation of animals
- 5. Sterilization of instrumentation and packs
- 6. Take radiographs and develop films
- 7. Perform daily treatments, observations, and diagnostic tests
- 8. Pre and post-operative care of surgical patients
- 9. Cleaning and maintaining equipment
- 10. Refilling expendable supplies
- 11. Recordkeeping
- 12. Filling prescriptions
- 13. Admitting and discharging patients
- 14. Computer information/data entry and retrieval
