

INTERLIBRARY LOAN GUIDELINES

Interlibrary loan allows borrowing/lending of materials among libraries. Available to all WCCCD faculty, staff, and students.

WCCCD participates in MeL Cat (Michigan Electronic Library) for resource sharing.

Patrons also have access to online resources at www.mel.org.

Materials include:

books and multimedia (sound recordings, videos).

Online resources and Learning Centers.

Requests can be made for items not held by WCCCD Learning Resource Centers.

- Delivery may take up to 20 days—request in advance.
- Borrowing limit: 5 items per person.
- Requests may be canceled if the limit is exceeded.
- Items must be returned by the due date.

Overdue/lost items incur fees—patron is responsible. For more info, visit a campus LRC or email lrchelp@wcccd.edu.

New interlibrary loan program through **MiLibraryCard** at https://milibrarycard.org/WCCCD patrons are able to borrow materials from participating libraries for 3 weeks.

New partnership with Detroit Public Library--Test Prep Books at the Detroit Public Library WCCCD students can borrow books by bringing their state ID or DL and their WCCCD ID card to any Detroit Public Library location. Books can be borrowed for 3 weeks.
